

MINUTES OF THE YORK TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES
REGULAR BOARD MEETING
TUESDAY, JANUARY 12, 2021

Held in the auditorium of the York Township Offices, 1502 South Meyers Road, Lombard, Illinois.

Supervisor John W. Valle called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.

Erica Militello led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Town Clerk Daniel J. Kordik called the roll: Supervisor Valle Present
Trustee Rupp Srch Present
Trustee Cuzzone Present
Trustee Morrissey Present
Trustee Mussatto Present

Also present: Township Attorney Kenneth Florey.

Trustee Morrissey moved to approve the minutes of the December 8, 2020 Regular Board Meeting, seconded by Trustee Mussatto. On roll call, Trustees Rupp Srch, Cuzzone, Morrissey, Mussatto, and Supervisor Valle voted "Aye". Motion passed.

Public Comment: None.

Trustee Morrissey moved that the bills in the amount of \$862,648.36, having been duly audited, be approved for payment and charged to the proper accounts, seconded by Trustee Rupp Srch. On roll call, Trustees Rupp Srch, Cuzzone, Morrissey, Mussatto, and Supervisor Valle voted "Aye." Motion passed.

Trustee Rupp Srch made a motion to accept the one bid received in the amount of the \$1.2 million for the purchase of the York Road Property, but in accordance with the terms and conditions established by the Township, with the closing to occur by March 31, 2021 or as agreed by counsel, seconded by Trustee Cuzzone. On roll call, Trustees Rupp Srch, Cuzzone, Morrissey, Mussatto, and Supervisor Valle voted "Aye." Motion passed.

Trustee Cuzzone made a motion to accept Clarke Environmental Mosquito Management's Contract for 2021 – 2024 in the amount of \$59,656 per year, seconded by Trustee Rupp Srch. On roll call, Trustees Rupp Srch, Cuzzone, Morrissey, Mussatto, and Supervisor Valle voted "Aye". Motion passed.


There was no closed session.

Under new business, Supervisor Valle showed a plaque awarded to Friends of York Township in appreciation for its sponsorship of Firebirds Soccer and highlighted press releases about the generous donations the Township Food Pantry received, including from Willowbrook High School and Villa Park's "Lion Larry" who donated two brand

new bicycles for Food Pantry recipients. Trustee Morrissey stated he will ask the Highway Commissioner and the Assessor for a report on what each has done in the past year. Trustee Cuzzone reported that even though the virtual Turkey Trot proceeds were down this year, the organization was still able to donate \$1,250.00 to the Township's Food Pantry. Trustee Rupp Srch asked about feedback on the newly installed canopy (which Supervisor Valle answered has been positive,) stated she would seek additional volunteers for Meals on Wheels, and announced that Tri-Town YMCA would be holding its monthly food distribution for those in need on January 22, 2021. There was no old business.

There being no further business, Trustee Cuzzone moved to adjourn the meeting to the Regular Board Meeting to be held on Tuesday, February 9, 2021, commencing at 7:30 p.m., seconded by Trustee Rupp Srch. Motion to adjourn passed by unanimous voice vote, whereupon the meeting adjourned.
