

MINUTES OF THE YORK TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES
REGULAR BOARD MEETING
TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 9, 2021

Held in the auditorium of the York Township Offices, 1502 South Meyers Road, Lombard, Illinois.

Supervisor John W. Valle called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.

Hunter Bennett led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Town Clerk Daniel J. Kordik called the roll:

Also present: Township Attorney Ken Florey.

Trustee Morrissey motioned to approve the minutes of the January 12, 2021 Regular Board Meeting, seconded by Trustee Mussatto. On roll call, Trustees Rupp Srch, Cuzzone, Morrissey, Mussatto, and Supervisor Valle voted "Aye". Motion passed.

Public Comment: None.

Trustee Morrissey moved that the bills in the amount of \$712,635.83, having been duly audited, be approved for payment and charged to the proper accounts, seconded by Trustee Mussatto. On roll call, Trustees Rupp Srch, Cuzzone, Morrissey, Mussatto, and Supervisor Valle voted "Aye". Motion passed.

Trustee Rupp Srch made a motion to approve the police contract with DuPage County in the amount of \$117,100.01 for the period Aril 1, 2021 through March 31, 2022, seconded by Trustee Cuzzone. On roll call, Trustees Rupp Srch, Cuzzone, Morrissey, Mussatto, and Supervisor Valle voted "Aye". Motion passed.

Supervisor Valle gave an update that the York Road property sale was "on track".

Trustee Cuzzone read a resolution honoring Elmhurst Mayor Steve Morley, and moved to adopt Resolution YT-02-09-21, seconded by Trustee Mussatto. On roll call, Trustees Cuzzone, Rupp Srch, Morrissey, and Mussatto voted "Aye". Motion passed.


Trustee Cuzzone made a motion that all minutes of past closed sessions not be released at this time because the need for confidentiality still exists, that the tape recordings of all closed sessions which are less than 18 months old also remain closed, and that the tape recordings of all closed sessions which are 18 months old or older be destroyed by the

Town Clerk, seconded by Trustee Morrissey. On roll call, Trustees Rupp Srch, Cuzzone, Morrissey, Mussatto, and Supervisor Valle voted "Aye". Motion passed.

There was no closed session. Under new business, Supervisor Valle announced that Friday was Trustee Cuzzone's birthday, that on February 19 there will be a food distribution for seniors, and on March 17, the mobile food bank will be at the Township. Under old business, Town Clerk Kordik shared an historical tid-bit from 1949 when Justice of the Peace Hackert was assessing \$5 fines on citations issued by Constable Grover for stop sign violations.

There being no further business, Trustee Cuzzone moved to adjourn the meeting to the Regular Board Meeting to be held on Tuesday, March 9, 2021 commencing at 7:30 p.m., seconded by Trustee Mussatto. Motion passed by unanimous voice vote, whereupon the meeting adjourned.
