

MINUTES OF THE YORK TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES
REGULAR BOARD MEETING
TUESDAY, MARCH 9, 2021

Held in the auditorium of the York Township Offices, 1502 South Meyers Road, Lombard, Illinois.

Supervisor John W. Valle called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.

Anthony Pacilli led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Town Clerk Daniel J. Kordik called the roll:

Also present: Township Attorney Ken Florey.

Supervisor Valle announced that long-time transportation manager Marge Snobl passed away and requested a moment of silence for her.

Trustee Morrissey motioned to approve the minutes of the February 9, 2021 Regular Board Meeting, seconded by Trustee Mussatto. On roll call, Trustees Rupp Srch, Cuzzone, Morrissey, Mussatto, and Supervisor Valle voted "Aye". Motion passed.

Public Comment: None.

Trustee Morrissey moved that the bills in the amount of \$957,710.31, having been duly audited, be approved for payment and charged to the proper accounts, seconded by Trustee Rupp Srch. On roll call, Trustees Rupp Srch, Cuzzone, Morrissey, Mussatto, and Supervisor Valle voted "Aye". Motion passed.

Town Budget Workshop: Supervisor Valle read the proposed appropriations for the Township for the fiscal year ending March 31, 2022:

General Town Fund:	\$3,179,747
Social Security (FICA) Fund:	\$ 142,000
Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund:	\$ 245,000
General Assistance Fund:	\$ 322,375
Police District Fund:	<u>\$ 121,000</u>
Total Appropriations:	\$4,010,122

Supervisor Valle noted that his goal was to have a flat budget and that this budget was less than last year.

Road and Bridge Budget Workshop: Highway Commissioner Dick Schroeder read the proposed appropriations for the Road District for the fiscal year ending Mach 31, 2022:

General Road Fund:	\$ 200,100

Permanent Road Fund:	\$5,262,943
Equipment and Building Fund:	<u>\$ 345,000</u>
Total Appropriations:	\$5,984,043

Highway Commissioner Schroeder noted that this budget is \$825,00 less than last year, 13.79 % less than last year, and \$3,000.000 is for the MacIntosh Subdivision project which may or may not be undertaken in the next fiscal year.

Supervisor Valle directed the Township Clerk to post the Supervisor’s Statement of Financial Affairs for the Annual Town Meeting.

Trustee Mussatto moved to approve the Agenda of the Annual Town Meeting of the Township of York on April 13, 2021 commencing at 7:00 p.m., seconded by Trustee Rupp Srch. On roll call, Trustees Rupp Srch, Cuzzone, Morrissey, Mussatto, and Supervisor Valle voted “Aye”. Motion passed.

Supervisor Valle moved to table the approval of Employee Handbook: FLMA & PTO, seconded by Trustee Cuzzone. On roll call, Trustees Rupp Srch, Cuzzone, Morrissey, Mussatto, and Supervisor Valle voted “Aye”. Item tabled.

Trustee Cuzzone moved to approve Resolution YT-03-09-21 to Amend the York Township 457 Plan #3, seconded by Trustee Rupp Srch. On roll call, Trustees Rupp Srch, Cuzzone, Morrissey, Mussatto, and Supervisor Valle voted “Aye.” Motion passed.


Trustee Mussatto read and moved to approve DuPage County River Sweep 2021 Resolution YT-03-09-21A, seconded by Trustee Rupp Srch. On roll call, Trustees Rupp Srch, Cuzzone, Morrissey, Mussatto, and Supervisor Valle voted “Aye.” Motion passed.

Supervisor Valle advised that legal counsel will give an update on the York Road property sale at the next meeting.

There was no closed session. Under new business, Supervisor Valle announced that the U.S. Census Bureau recognized York Township for helping to achieve a successful 2020 Census, that York Township’s next meal distribution will be held on March 17th, that on Friday, our Seniors will be receiving meal packages here, and that York Township recently honored centenarian twins Tracie Banser and Lonnie Buseman. Trustee Rupp Srch announced that on Saturday, the St. Alexander Knights of Columbus are having a drive-up Corned Beef and Italian Beef dinner at the Villa Park VFW. Under old business, Trustee Cuzzone announced that the Elmhurst St. Patrick’s Day Parade was cancelled this year due to COVID-19, but it is hoped that it will take place next year.

There being no further business, Trustee Cuzzone moved to adjourn the meeting to the Regular Board Meeting to be held on Wednesday, April 14, 2021 commencing at 7:30 p.m., seconded by Trustee Mussatto. On roll call, Trustees Rupp Srch, Cuzzone,

Morrissey, Mussatto, and Supervisor Valle voted "Aye". Motion passed, meeting adjourned.
