

MINUTES OF THE YORK TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES  
REGULAR BOARD MEETING  
WEDNESDAY, APRIL 14, 2021

Held in the auditorium of the York Township Offices, 1502 South Meyers Road, Lombard, Illinois.

Supervisor John W. Valle called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.

Anthony Pacilli led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Town Clerk Kordik called the roll:

Also present: Township Attorney Ken Florey.

Trustee Rupp Srch moved to approve the minutes of the March 9, 2021 Regular Board Meeting, seconded by Trustee Morrissey. On roll call, Trustees Rupp Srch, Cuzzone, Morrissey, Mussatto, and Supervisor Valle voted "Aye." Motion passed.

Public Comment: There were no comments from the public.

Trustee Morrissey moved that the bills in the amount of \$559,591.28, having been duly audited, be approved for payment and charged to the proper accounts, seconded by Trustee Mussatto. Trustee Cuzzone had questions about one of the bills and requested that an expenditure in the amount of \$17,855.63 be tabled. Trustee Morrissey then moved to table his original motion, seconded by Trustee Cuzzone. On roll call on the motion to table, Trustees Rupp Srch, Cuzzone, Morrissey, Mussatto, and Supervisor Valle voted "Aye". Motion passed, original motion tabled. Then Trustee Morrissey made a motion to approve for payment and charge to the proper accounts, bills in the amount of \$541,735.65, seconded by Trustee Mussatto. On roll call, Trustees Rupp Srch, Cuzzone, Morrissey, Mussatto, and Supervisor Valle voted "Aye". Motion passed.

Trustee Rupp Srch made a motion to approve a three year contract with WIPFLI to provide auditing services, seconded by Trustee Cuzzone. On roll call, Trustees Rupp Srch, Cuzzone, Morrissey, Mussatto, and Supervisor Valle voted "Aye". Motion passed.

Township Attorney Florey gave an update on the York Road property sale and recommended that if earnest money was not received before the next regular board meeting, that the Supervisor be authorized to terminate the sales contract. Trustee Morrissey made a motion to grant the Supervisor the authority to terminate the sales contract if the contract purchaser has not paid its earnest money by the next regular board meeting, seconded by Trustee Mussatto. On roll call, Trustees Rupp Srch, Cuzzone, Morrissey, Mussatto, and Supervisor Valle voted "Aye". Motion passed.

Trustee Rupp Srch moved to re-appoint Court Haring as an Oakbrook Terrace Fire Protection District Trustee from 4/10/2021 to 4/10/2024 and Frank Vosicky as a York Center Fire Protection District Trustee from 4/10/2021 to 4/10/2024, seconded by Trustee Cuzzone. On roll call Trustees Rupp Srch, Cuzzone, Morrissey, Mussatto, and Supervisor Valle voted "Aye". Motion passed.

Trustee Mussatto made a motion to re-appoint members of the Senior Advisory Committee: Jeffrey Redick and Michael Ledonne to 3 year terms from 4/14/21 to 4/14/2024, and Cathy Jordan to a 2 year term from 4/14/2021 to 4/10/2024, seconded by Trustee Cuzzone. On roll call, Trustees Rupp Srch, Cuzzone, Morrissey, Mussatto, and Supervisor Valle voted "Aye". Motion passed.


Trustee Morrissey made a motion to make donations of \$5,000 to TLC Camp for children with cancer; \$1,000 to sponsor the Firebirds Soccer Club; \$1,000 to sponsor Elmhurst Baseball Leagues; \$1,000 to the Willowbrook Parent Organization for Senior Scholarships; and \$100 to Boy Scout Troop #140, seconded by Trustee Morrissey. On roll call, Trustees Rupp Srch, Cuzzone, Morrissey, Mussatto, and Supervisor Valle voted "Aye". Motion passed.

There was no closed session.

Under new business, Trustee Rupp Srch announced that the Villa Park Kiwanis Club was having its annual onion sale. Trustee Morrissey complimented Supervisor Valle and staff for being safe for the last year resulting in the Township receiving a dividend from its TOIRMA insurance. Under old business, Town Clerk Kordik shared an historical tid-bit in Town Clerk Adam Glos' penmanship from April 1853 when there were three Highway Commissioners. Supervisor Valle stated that it was "unbelievable" the amount of donations that the Township has received.

There being no further business, Trustee Cuzzone moved to adjourn the meeting to the Regular Board Meeting to be held on Tuesday, May 11, 2021, commencing at 7:30 p.m., seconded by Trustee Rupp Srch. Motion approved by unanimous voice vote, meeting adjourned.
