

MINUTES OF THE YORK TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES  
REGULAR BOARD MEETING  
TUESDAY, MAY 11, 2021

Held in the auditorium of the York Township Offices, 1502 South Meyers Road, Lombard, Illinois.

Supervisor John W. Valle called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.

Erica Militello, Anthony Pacilli, and Julia Morrissey led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Town Clerk Daniel J. Kordik called the roll:

Highway Commissioner Dick Schroeder, Assessor Deanna Wilkins and Township Attorney Ken Florey were also present.

At 7:33 p.m., Supervisor Valle opened the Public Hearing for the Town and Road District Budgets and Appropriations, asked for any comments from the public, and hearing none, moved to close the public hearing at 7:35 p.m., seconded by Trustee Mussatto. On roll call, Trustees Rupp Srch, Cuzzone, Morrissey, Mussatto, and Supervisor Valle voted "Aye". Motion passed.

Trustee Morrissey moved to approve the minutes of the April 14, 2021 Regular Board Meeting, seconded by Trustee Rupp Srch. On roll call, Trustees Rupp Srch, Cuzzone, Morrissey, Mussatto, and Supervisor Valle voted "Aye." Motion passed.

Public Comment: None.

Trustee Morrissey moved that the bills in the amount of \$625,175.00, having been duly audited, be approved for payment and charged to the proper accounts, seconded by Trustee Mussatto. On roll call, Trustees Rupp Srch, Cuzzone, Morrissey, Mussatto, and Supervisor Valle voted "Aye." Motion passed.

Supervisor Valle read the appropriations for the Township for the 2021-2022 Fiscal Year:

Trustee Rupp Srch moved to adopt 2021/2022 Fiscal Year Town Budget and Appropriation Ordinance YT-05-11-21T, seconded by Trustee Morrissey. On roll, Trustees Rupp Srch, Cuzzone, Morrissey, Mussatto, and Supervisor Valle voted “Aye”. Motion passed. Ordinance adopted.

Highway Commissioner Dick Schroeder read the appropriations for the Road District for the 2021/2022 Fiscal Year:

General Road Fund:	\$ 201,000
Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund:	\$ 120,000
Social Security Fund:	\$ 55,000
Permanent Road Fund:	\$5,062,943
Equipment and Building Fund:	<u>\$ 345,000</u>
Total Appropriations:	\$5,784,043

Trustee Cuzzone moved to adopt 2021/2022 Fiscal Year Road District Budget and Appropriation Ordinance YT-05-11-21R, seconded by Trustee Rupp Srch. On roll call, Trustees Rupp Srch, Cuzzone, Morrissey, Mussatto, and Supervisor Valle voted “Aye”. Motion passed. Ordinance adopted.

Trustee Cuzzone moved to adopt and read Resolution YT-05-12-21 in memory of Sister Thomas Leo Monahan and moved to approve, seconded by Trustee Mussatto. On roll call, Trustees Rupp Srch, Cuzzone, Morrissey, Mussatto, and Supervisor Valle voted “Aye”. Motion passed.

Trustee Morrissey read and moved to adopt Resolution YT-05-12-21A honoring World War II Veteran Sir Peter Gilea on his 100<sup>th</sup> Birthday, seconded by Trustee Rupp Srch. On roll call, Trustees Rupp Srch, Cuzzone, Morrissey, Mussatto, and Supervisor Valle voted “Aye”. Motion passed.

Trustee Mussatto moved to re-appoint Members of the Youth Advisory Board: Kristen Savage-Stringer to a 2 year term from 5/11/21 to 5/11/23, Nicole Young to a 2 year from 5/11/21 to 5/11/23, Amy Kofink to a 2 year term from 5/11/21 to 5/11/23, and Angela Tanner to a 3 year term from 5/11/21 to 5/11/24, seconded by Trustee Cuzzone. On roll call, Trustees Rupp Srch, Cuzzone, Morrissey, Mussatto, and Supervisor Valle voted “Aye”. Motion passed.

Trustee Rupp Srch made a motion to donate \$1000 to sponsor Lombard Baseball League’s 2021 season, seconded by Trustee Mussatto. On roll Trustees Rupp Srch, Cuzzone, Morrissey, Mussatto, and Supervisor Valle voted “Aye”. Motion passed.

There was no closed session.

Under old business, Town Clerk Kordik told the story of his idea to share tid-bits of history at board meetings from the Township’s trove of old records dating back to the 1800s and of when he first became Clerk finding a Vote Tally Sheet from the April 1973 Election containing his mom’s signature as an Election Judge at the Elmhurst Hospital


polling place among those records. Clerk Kordik read from the minutes of the October 11, 2005 board meeting when he was appointed Town Clerk upon the motion of Trustee Paul Hinds. Clerk Kordik thanked former Trustee Hinds, Supervisor Valle and the citizens of York Township for the opportunity to serve.

Supervisor Valle recognized Circuit Judge Anne Celine O'Halloran Walsh, re-elected Lombard Village President Keith Giagnorio, newly elected Villa Park Village President Nick Cuzzone and Sheriff Jim Mendrick in the audience.

Supervisor Valle then recognized outgoing Trustee John Morrissey for his 9 years of service as Township Trustee. Trustee Morrissey expressed that the Township gets a lot done by working together. Supervisor Valle then recognized outgoing Township Clerk Dan Kordik for his years of service as Township Clerk from 2005- 2021.

There being no further business, Trustee Cuzzone moved to adjourn the meeting to the Regular Board Meeting to be held on Tuesday, June 8, 2021, commencing at 7:30 p.m., seconded by Trustee Mussatto. Motion approved by unanimous voice vote, whereupon the meeting adjourned.
