

**MINUTES OF THE YORK TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES
REGULAR BOARD MEETING
TUESDAY, JUNE 8, 2021**

Held in the auditorium of the York Township Offices, 1502 South Meyers Road, Lombard, Illinois.

Supervisor John W. Valle called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.

Deputy Supervisor Nadia Hajduk led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Town Clerk Anthony A. Cuzzone called the roll: Supervisor Valle Present
Trustee Rupp Srch Present
Trustee Pacilli Present
Trustee Militello Present
Trustee Mussatto Present

Also present: Township Attorney Ken Florey.

Trustee Rupp Srch motioned to approve the minutes of the May 11, 2021 Regular Board Meeting, seconded by Trustee Militello. On roll call, Trustees Rupp Srch, Pacilli, Militello, Mussatto, and Supervisor Valle voted "Aye". Motion passed.

Public Comment: None.

Trustee Mussatto moved that the bills in the amount of \$407,388.96, having been duly audited, be approved for payment and charged to the proper accounts, seconded by Trustee Rupp Srch. On roll call, Trustees Rupp Srch, Pacilli, Militello, Mussatto, and Supervisor Valle voted "Aye". Motion passed.

Supervisor Valle presented a TIPS company proposal from Miracle Method Surface Refinishing for making improvements to the bathrooms including refinishing floors, walls, and paint, installing new partitions, improvements to the salon in the Senior Center, janitor closet, and replacing tile in the cafeteria. Trustee Rupp Srch spoke favorably about the company that they do exemplary work. Supervisor Valle stated Miracle Method does work for the Dorms at the University of Chicago, Addison Township has used this company, and Wayne Township has plans on using this company.


Trustee Rupp Srch made a motion to approve the proposal from Miracle Method Surface Refinishing in the amount not to exceed \$74,000.00, seconded by Trustee Mussatto. On roll call, Trustees Rupp Srch, Pacilli, Militello, Mussatto, and Supervisor Valle voted "Aye". Motion passed.

There was no closed session. Under new business, Supervisor Valle mentioned Trustee Rupp Srch is looking for someone from the Board of Trustees to liaison with the TRI-

TOWN YMCA as her replacement. Trustee Rupp Srch explained a committee will be looking into the emotional and mental health issues that many children are faced with coming out of the COVID Pandemic. Supervisor Valle announced that for the summer meetings, sport coat and business casual dress will be acceptable. Supervisor Valle congratulated and welcomed the new members to the Board and offered any assistance needed from anyone on the Board. Under old business, Supervisor Valle reported Kiwanis Club member Hosanna Korynecki hand-delivered over 150 pounds of Vidalia onions to the York Township Food Pantry. The onions were donated by Gladys and Dave Novotny of Elmhurst through the Kiwanis annual onion fundraiser of which Trustee Rupp Srch is a member. Town Clerk Cuzzone shared an historical tid-bit from a June 7, 1969 Town Board meeting where the current Trustees were called Auditors, meetings began at 8:30 pm, and one of the Auditors was Lee Daniels. They were discussing the Board Audit and payment procedures.

There being no further business, Trustee Rupp Srch moved to adjourn the meeting to the Regular Board Meeting to be held on Tuesday, July 13, 2021 commencing at 7:30 p.m., seconded by Trustee Pacilli. Motion passed by unanimous voice vote, whereupon the meeting adjourned.
