President's Report:

Michael prompts the board to view the mental health board budget; Stacy Schroeder has redone our board budget that we approved in October. The format is now in the format of York Township, will be posted and ready for anybody to view. There is a new line on revenues that states the 1.5 million for property tax. This is the levy that the York Township trustees approved last year. This is the anticipated revenues that we will be receiving when we get the levies coming in, but before we actually disperse the monies this year, Stacy anticipates that the interest income from when the money is sitting here will start to collect interest. She anticipates that that will be about \$15,000 for the year of 2026. We will need to allocate that \$15,000 somewhere. Michael explains that from here on out, any changes to the budget will be discussed by the board members and published to the website, allowing 30 days for the public to give their comments.

We will then vote on the new budget at the next meeting. Michael explains that keeping the budget information on the website is a benefit to the public as we are giving transparency. Lastly, Michael spoke about the software Foundant; he will be in touch with the salesperson for the software soon, as he is out of the country at this time.

Board Meeting Comments:

Dr. Melissa Williams was present at the meeting and gave her summary of how the township is going to move forward with including the 708 mental health board in the township needs assessment, as she is spearheading the strategic planning for this year.

Dr. Williams gave a brief background of her education and experiencing working for non for profits. She elaborated on the benefit of the 708 board and township needs assessment being sent out as one assessment as to not cause confusion to the public. She spoke of a research company, POLC, saying that there is a benchmarking tool in the survey, which can help us compare our performance to about sixty other municipalities. Having a survey that brings effective data will essentially allow us to build the strategic plan.

Carmen asked a clarifying question about what we will do with the data and if we have any hypotheses that we are looking at; Dr. Williams responded that the needs assessment will help us fill in the gaps in the community in terms of mental health services, the hypothesis is more about filling a gap and figuring out what those gaps are.

Discussion about the \$15,000 interest income, listing it in the expenditure line as “grant software”.

Micahel makes a motion to move to approve the 708 Mental Health Board collaborating with the York Township Board to move forward with a Mental Health Board assessment in conjunction with the York Township Board. Micahel Also moves to combine with York Township for a strategic plan.

Motion passed by all board members present.
